POSITION OVERVIEW

Our **Senior Buyer** will report directly to the Purchasing Manager and has overall responsibility for sourcing, contracting, planning, and supplier management for ATI's direct material spend.

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Identify, evaluate, and contract with new suppliers, and maintain relationships with existing suppliers, for materials relative to ATI production. Continuously improve material costs, quality, and supply chain reliability.
- Properly plan ATI material purchases to prevent stock outs.
- Develop and/or utilize standard methods for Requests for Proposals (RFPs), Requests for Information (RFIs), and Requests for Quotes (RFQs).
- Review and analyze incoming RFPs, RFIs, and RFQs and recruit and maintain suppliers that provide high quality products and services while optimizing costs.
- Develop and implement ATI's vendor scorecard system and then monitor and communicate vendor performance through the system.
- Participate in ATI's Material Review Board to properly disposition nonconforming material and ensure the company receives all material credits/refunds.
- Communicate with Accounts Payable on invoice resolution regarding pricing/quantity discrepancies.
- Issue purchase orders to support manufacturing and ATI engineering. Track and expedite as necessary to ensure timely delivery.
- Negotiate effective and competitive supply agreements which protect the interests of ATI.
- Stay up to date on component and commodity prices, including printed circuit boards, electronic components, aluminum, iron, petroleum, and steel, to better understand risks and opportunities with regards to component as well as raw material costs.
- Maintain the ERP system with proper replenishment and lead time information.
- Responsible for monitoring warehouse inventory and performing cycle counting duties and root cause analysis to ensure that all materials are properly verified to be reflective of reported inventory.
- Monitor and communicate status of key metrics through dashboard reporting.
- Participation in the Engineering Change Order process.
